

INTRODUCTION TO OPTI-VISION

National Vision Administrators, LLC. is the administrator of your vision discount plan. As an innovative leader in the field of vision care administration, NVA has designed this program with your convenience in mind. Our staff is comprised of qualified professional administrative personnel who are available to assist you.

HOW OPTI-VISION PROGRAM WORKS

NVA offers an extensive network of participating Ophthalmologists, Optometrists and Opticians to serve you. Opti-Vision discounts are available only from participating providers.

NVA has designed the program to be simple to use. There is no paperwork. Present your NVA ID card to a participating provider. There is no limit to the number of times you can obtain eyewear at the discounted prices.* This card cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer (including, but not limited to, coupons, special promotions, sales, etc.).

* The 25% discount on disposable contact lenses is limited to once per 12 month period.

WHERE TO GET BENEFITS

NVA has a network of participating Ophthalmologists, Optometrists and Opticians to serve you. You must utilize an NVA participating provider in order to obtain vision care discounts. ELIGIBILITY

All enrolled employees and their covered dependent(s) (if limited or family coverage is indicated on the NVA ID card) are eligible to receive discounted services and eyewear.

EXAMINATIONS

An exam includes case history, examination for pathology or anomalies, job visual acuity (clearness of vision), refraction, and tonometry (glaucoma test). *A comprehensive exam does not include contact lens analysis or fitting fees.*

ROUTINE VISION ANALYSIS: \$38.00 (PATIENT COST)

FRAMES

The retail pricing on frames varies by provider but is often 3-4 times the wholesale cost. The discount from NVA providers is the wholesale price plus 50%. This example illustrates the savings of wholesale pricing discounts over retail discounts.

CONTACT LENSES

The participating provider will charge his or her usual, customary and reasonable fee, less twenty-five percent (25%) for contact lenses, including the contact lens examination.

NOTE: The 25% discount on disposable contact lenses is limited to once per 12 month period.

LASIK SURGERY

NVA has a national panel of credentialed surgeons who provide Lasik surgery at discounted rates for those covered by the NVA program. The discounts range from 15-25% of Reasonable and Customary Allowances.

CUSTOMER SERVICE
